ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

- 1.1 This Statement sets out the policy of Dale Building Maintenance Ltd (The Company) in respect of our general work activities in the construction and allied industries and those of any employee, self-employed person and contractor under our control whose acts or omissions may have an adverse effect on the environment. 
